Ever wonder what makes a hymn popular and causes it to be sung over many years? In over 1 million hymns that have been written in the Christian era, most hymn books contain 500-800 hymns. Our current United Methodist Hymnal contains 624. There are several factors that make a hymn popular. The first factor is the quality of rich poetic imagery and the clarity of how it expresses our faith such as "Abide with Me". Another factor is the testimony of the author rings true and conveys a personal relationship with the Lord such as "It is Well with My Soul". The melody also needs to be singable or have a catchy tune to become popular such as "When the Roll Is Called Up Yonder". God's providence in a hymn may cause it to become a favorite such as "A Mighty Fortress is Our God" as it became a battle cry for the church during the Reformation, as was "The Church is One Foundation" used to correct doctrinal errors. Lastly, the songs that we learn in our childhood stay with us all our life such as "Jesus Loves Me"!
