2021 FINANCIAL SUMMARY AND HIGHLIGHTS

This past year was planned as one of renovation, improvements, and outreach. Our Spend Plan was for \$512,270 and we executed \$426,758. When it came to our actual income vs. expenses, we were short only -\$733 for the year. This was greatly supported by the generous designated funds and tithing which allowed us to keep our operational spending to a minimum.

Here are some of our accomplishments that made a big difference: Our audio and visual system was upgraded to include the WIFI, cameras, and large screen display monitors; Renovation of the upstairs bathrooms (\$87,400); New flooring (\$9,713); New boiler (\$81,500); education wing air conditioner (\$35,445); roof repairs (\$25,000). Thanks to all for your generous support for the following ministries: Beach Bags (\$14,583), Holiday Families (\$1,323), Missions (General) (\$3,301), Sudan (\$13,267), Winter Shelter (\$1,125), Baylake Elementary (\$620), UMMen (\$9,530), and UMWomen (\$115). we were blessed with the forgiveness of our Payroll Protection Plan Ioan (\$55,580). I would like to give a very special thank you to Bob Howard and Gary St. John for their efforts above and beyond in managing your selfless contributions to ensure our goals were met. Overall, it was a good year and I look forward to seeing how Baylake continues to enrich our congregation and the community in the coming year. Clay Curry
