The Good News!

As we finish An Unlikely Advent by Rachel Billups, we end the book with the assurance that God shows up in our lives. God chose to show up to shepherds living in the fields and watching over their flock (Luke 2:8-20). Shepherds were the working class at the time of Jesus' birth. They were probably the most unlikely group of people to receive this miraculous news. God shows up to the most unlikely people just as God shows up to us when we may least expect. God chose shepherds to receive the great news just as he chooses each one of us to receive the good news of God's great love through the gift of Jesus. We need to choose to engage in the power of God's presence and to know that God shows up in all the ordinary parts of our lives. God shows up in our "dark nights and ordinary days" (p. 110). "God shows up when we do not think we have the energy to be a blessing in someone else's life." "God's presence and power are available to us if we would just open our eyes and our schedules to God's presence...God is here and God is present" (p. 111).
