During Lent we are studying the book, *The Third Day: Living the Resurrection*, by Tom Berlin.

His book follows the lives of some of Jesus' disciples and how the resurrection transformed their lives and can transform ours as well. The resurrection of Jesus is an "experience of the power of God and a truth about Jesus that offers us confidence. Because Jesus was resurrected on the third day, we know that God offers new beginnings, no matter what the facts of our present reality seem to tell us." We all need the power of the resurrection to give us "hope, new life, and the assurance that God is present not only in our brightest moments but also our darkest, including the consideration of our own mortality." Some people chose to give up something during the 40 days of Lent (not counting Sundays), but I encourage people to take something on. I urge you to add something to your life that will bring you closer to God and closer to each other during this Lent. May I suggest you commit to participating in one of our small groups that will meet six times during Lent to study the book and to learn and to grow together in how to harness the power of the resurrection to live more fully into the life God has called you! COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT – ACTS 2 DINING GROUPS LAUNCHING SOON!


